Subject: All expectation leads to suffering

Good day all. We live in a world of many promises ~ the promise to be wealthy, have a happy relationship, have all that we want, suffer no distress, be without any loss, and so on and so on and so on. This list of promises we are conditioned by a conditioning world that conditions us we are naturally entitled to this perfect life ~ without any interruption to its unraveling perfectly, in a perfect stream in our life. One may call it the "Cinderella Complex" ~ where we naturally expect, because of the pain of this life, that our life will get better and only get better. And ANY interruption to this perfect stream of wonderment, of things we have amassed, of accomplishments we have accomplished, of plans we have planned, is met by bewilderment and confusion and anger and frustration and pain and despair. Our pride of entitlement, of that of a child, who wants and wants and only *ever* wants, and never sets sail on the path of renunciation, the time immemorial path of the saints.
